ANNUAL REPORT (2023-2024)

Dr. G. D. Pol Foundation Y.M.T Dental College & Hospital has successfully completed 23 years in imparting value education and has a notable contribution in the field of dental health care. The academic and extension activities developed are aimed at fulfilling the vision and mission of the institution. The main objective is to inculcate knowledge and enhance skill among students, along with ethics, compassion and social responsibilities.

The institution was started in the year 2000 with an aim to be the most preferred dental institution providing education, infrastructure and treatment facilities to students and patients. The annual intake of 100 students was underway in the undergraduate program. The postgraduate program was started from 2005 in 5 specialty courses initially and by 2010 added 3 more specialities. The undergraduate and post graduate programs along with the certification and PhD courses are affiliated to MUHS, and recognised by the Dental Council of India.

The highlight of the academic year 2023-2024 was the NAAC PTV of the institute, which was on 11-12th August, 2023 which earned us a B+ grade, as declared on 21st August, 2023. Thus, YMTDC is now a NAAC accredited institute.

ADMISSIONS:

The undergraduate & postgraduate admissions take place through the All India NEET UG & PG exam and centralised counselling. During this year, the total number of admissions for BDS program was 100 and for MDS, it was 34. Due consideration was also given to equality and inclusiveness by providing reservation of seats to all categories as dictated by the Government of India. In this academic year, 57 BDS & 20 MDS students were admitted in the reserved category including 8 & 2 in the SC category, 4 &1 in ST, 19 & 9 from OBC, 9 & 3 from NTVJ, 17 & 5 from EWS for BDS & MDS respectively and remaining in the category for others. In this academic year, all enrolled students were from the state of Maharashtra. In this academic year, all students who enrolled were from the state of Maharashtra.

The current academic year started in the month of August. The Institution has 573 students and 130 teaching faculty.

The summer exams were conducted in the month of July, 2023 &Winter during January, 2024. The number of students who appeared for the final BDS & MDS exam were 79 (Summer), 23 (Winter), 35 (MDS) of which 72 BDS students in Summer and 18 BDS, 34 MDS students passed.

PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

The Institution is dedicated to being an environment-conscious and sustainable campus. We have installed solar panels and also used LED bulbs. We have taken Green Campus Initiatives for the Institution where in we have pedestrian friendly pathways and landscaped the campus with trees and plants, have restricted entry for automobiles and banned single-use plastics.

The Institution has also taken measures to be a **Divyanjan** friendly infrastructure with ramps/lifts with easy access to classrooms, disabled-friendly washrooms, signage including tactile paths, lights, display boards and signposts.

Library: There are 8067 books and 2305 total bound volume journals. E-consortium with access to 316 journals, 27 magazines and 32 E- Books was provided this academic year. 28 journals were purchased additionally in this year. Library audit of stock verification was held in the months of April-May 2024.

EBSCO training session was organized by library for the staff members on 7th August, 2023.
