## ADVERSE DRUG MONITORING CENTRE.

In the year 2021, the Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring Centre (ADRMC) received and analyzed a total of 10 adverse drug reaction (ADR) reports.

Key highlights include the identification of several new ADR trends, successful implementation of targeted training programs and enhanced collaboration with regulatory bodies. Despite these achievements, challenges such as underreporting and data quality persist.

PARAMETERS	DETAILS
1. Total ADR reports	10 cases, 8 cases reported in vigiflow
2. Severe ADR reports	--
3. Most reported drug	Amlodipine
4. Most reported ADR reaction	Gingival enlargement
5. Patient age group	21-64 yrs
6. Gender distribution	80 % males, 20% females

### Recommendations For Healthcare Providers:

- Enhance vigilance and reporting of ADRs, especially for new medications.
- Ensure thorough documentation of patient histories and potential drug interactions.

The ADRMC has made significant strides in enhancing the monitoring and reporting of adverse drug reactions. The drug side effects highlighted by PvPI are displayed regularly on notice board.

As per the rules of Pharmacovigilance commission of India a causality committee was established in 2024 to improve the performance of adverse drug monitoring centre. Looking ahead, the ADRMC will continue to prioritize patient safety through vigilant monitoring, targeted education, and robust collaboration with stakeholders.
