As per the rules of Pharmacovigilance commission of India a causality committee was established in 2024 to improve the performance of adverse drug monitoring centre. Looking ahead, the ADRMC will continue to prioritize patient safety through vigilant monitoring, targeted education, and robust collaboration with stakeholders.

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

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

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

The participants were extremely enthusiastic and also had a great learning experience from the event.



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


